# Lounge Manual



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#### To the owner

Congratulations on purchasing an LP Morgan CineTheatre Club Lounge.

Please take a moment to review this manual, as it will ensure you many years of trouble-free service from your new CineTheatre Club Lounge.

#### Please read this instruction manual before installing

The LP Morgan CineTheatre Club Lounge is designed to be modular to allow for you to configure the exact seating requirements for your home theatre clients

#### LP Morgan CineTheatre Club Lounge Features

- Multiple seat configurations. The individual seats are joined by a wedge to create that real in the round theatre experience.
- Fully motorised reclining mechanism.
- LP Morgan Club Lounge features a two stage reclining process; stage one the foot stool extends, then stage two the back seat reclines.
- When fully extended the back of the seat requires an additional 175mm of space and infront an additional 550mm of space.

## Installing the back support

After unpacking the LP Morgan CineTheatre Club Lounge locate the seat back support.

Align the locking mechanism positioned at bottom of the back support, with metal post located at the back of the chair. Then lock it by pushing the back support downward as shown in Figure 1.




# Joining two seats


Step 1. Locate the locking mechanism at the side of the SINGLE ARM seat. Then align and insert it to the joining DOUBLE ARM-ONE WEDGE seat.




Step 2. Under the seat locate the DIN plug and connect it to the controller cable.



Step 3. Each lounge has its own individual power supply which needs to be connected to the Plug Pack and plugged into AC power.




Step 4. Install the back supports. (See Figure 1 on page 4).



# Joining three seats


Step 1. Locate the locking mechanism at the side of the SINGLE WEDGE ARM seat. Align and insert it to the joining DOUBLE ARM-ONE WEDGE seat. Then locate the locking mechanism of SINGLE ARM SEAT, and join it to the two connected seats.



Step 2. Under the seat locate the Line DIN plug and connect it to the socket of the joining seat.




Step 3. Install the back supports. (See Figure 1 on page 4).



## Joining four seats


Step 1. Locate the locking mechanism at the side of the SINGLE WEDGE ARM seat. Align and insert it to the joining DOUBLE ARM-ONE WEDGE seat. Perform the same action on the other SINGLE WEDGE ARM seats and SINGLE ARM SEATS to connect the four seats.



Step 2. Under the seat locate the Line DIN plug and connect it to the socket of the joining seat.



Step 3. Install the back supports. (See Figure 1 on page 4).



#### Leather care

One of most important things to do is to clean your furniture regularly, if possible every week by simply wiping with a soft, clean cloth.

Vacuuming with a soft brush extension on your vacuum, and dusting the couch monthly, or more frequently, is a good idea.

Wipe it down with leather cleaner and treat any stains promptly in order to keep the leather couch looking its best.

To avoid squeaky surplus noise when the lounges are in motion, it may be necessary to treat area of the couch where the leather rubs against leather with protectants such as: Leather Polish, Armor All, Bee's wax, Silicon spray, etc.)
