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

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
Unpacking the Screenboard


1 x Pre-Assembled Screenboard Frame with Acrylic Screen.




1 x 4mm Allen Key




4 x M6 Cage Nuts with BH bolts (nuts pre installed)



4 x Hanging Tabs




1 x Ezymount Rail

Spirit Level




At least 3 x Screws to suit Wall type.

Ezy-mount Installation


Ensure height of mounting holes are 23mm below the height at which the top edge of the frame will be. Using spirit level, secure ezy-mount to wall or mounting surface.

Ezymount installation using spirit level.



Placing the frame onto the ezy-mount rail

Hook the screen on to the top edge of the Ezy-Mount at a 15° angle from the vertical. Carefully tilt frame towards wall and slowly release.



You can slide screen sideways until it lines up with the image horizontally. Make sure the projector sits perpendicular to the screen.

Assembly Instructions

Installing and using hanging tabs

Hanging tabs can be used to secure the Screenboard in a fixed position. This can be done either in conjunction with the ezy-mount in place or with the hanging tabs on their own.

We recommend that each hanging tab be placed at or near the corner of the frame. This is to ensure maximum stability of the frame.

Hanging tab attachment to frame detail.

Note: Fastners from hanging tab to mounting surface are not included.



Once hanging tab to cage nut as shown.

Secure hanging tab to cage nut as shown.

Secured, it can be moved along the frame as shown.

To mounting surface.



If using hanging tabs in conjunction with ezymount, be sure to use 6mm spacers between the mounting surface and each hanging tab.

Whiteboard Use and Screen Care

Cleaning your screen surface

Screenboards are only suitable for use with dry erase or wipe dry markers

To clean the surface when using as a whiteboard there are several options-

- A clean dry cloth will remove the dry eraser mark
- Dampening your clean cloth will also remove the dry eraser mark
- For stubborn marks use methylated spirits and a clean dry cloth



To avoid damage to your projection and whiteboard surface do not use cleaning agents that -

- Are abrasive! You can damage the A/R coatings.
- Contain acetone or dichlormethan

Cleaning your frame

- If your frame is powder-coated or anodised, use water with a mild detergent or methylated spirits and a soft cloth to wash off any marks. Rinse and dry with a clean cloth or towel. Take care not to wet the screen surface.
- If your frame features a flocked velour finish, use a lint brush to remove any dust on the frame.
